Each episode explains who Hannah considers responsible for her suicide, placing the responsibility of the suicide on the survivors. We wanted to make you aware of the show as we have heard quite a few students talking about it. We highly encourage you to talk with your childres if they are watching the show to ensure they are processing its content in a meaningful and pro-social manner. Critics fear that some adolescents may be sensationalizing the show and the suicide.
