After-school activities will run for six to twelve weeks depending on the club (see session dates on page 2); starting the week of **January 10<sup>th</sup>**.

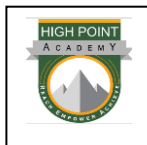

## Activity Descriptions and Sign-Up Information

**Wilderness Club:** In Wilderness club students will learn how to properly plan and pack for a hiking and camping trip. How to properly set up a tent and how to shoot a bow and arrow. Along with camping and archery, students will learn basic survival skills like methods to get clean drinking water and how to protect against animals, including information about animals, and what to look out for.

**Session Dates:** January 11, January 13, January 18, January 20, January 25, January 27, February 1, February 3, February 8, February 10, February 15, February 17

**Robotics Club:** Students will use LEGO robotics kits to build robots that are able to perform simple tasks (shooting a basketball, moving small objects, etc.). Students will work collaboratively to produce designs and trouble-shoot and refine the robotics building process.

**Session Dates:** January 12, January 19, January 26, February 2, February 9, February 16, February 23, March 2, March 23, March 30, April 6, April 13

**NO CLASS ON:** March 9, March 16

**Yearbook Club:** Do you like to take pictures? Do you want to help capture a school year? Then join the yearbook club and help create memories that will last a lifetime. During this club students will help collect pictures for the yearbook club. Students will help create and make pages that will be part of the yearbook on chrome books. All students that are part of the club will receive a free yearbook as part of their help.
