A Message from Executive Director/Principal, Keri Melmed

Dear HPA Families,

Tri-County Health Department has announced that school masking is no longer mandated in schools. Therefore, starting today, Monday, February 7, masks are no longer required, for students and staff in Arapahoe and Adams County. As a school, we have followed the expertise and guidelines set forth by Tri-County Health, CDC, and CDPHE. These organizations have helped us successfully navigate the pandemic and we are continuing to follow their recommendations. As such, moving forward, masks will not be required for students and staff at High Point Academy. We realize that for some members of the com-



munity this decision about masks is disappointing and for other community members it is a welcomed message. As we have stated from the beginning, High Point is following the guidance of Tri-County Health Department, and will therefore no longer mandate masks. We will continue to monitor transmission rates and if we see a spike we will consult with Tri-County Health and make any necessary adjustments. Students and staff may continue to wear a mask and their right to do so will be respected.

High Point Academy will continue to adhere to COVID precautions and mitigating strategies that have proven to be effective in maintaining the health and safety of our students and staff:

Vaccination:

Vaccination continues to be the most effective strategy for preventing the spread of COVID-19 and serious illness or hospitalization from the virus. High Point Academy will continue to hold vaccine clinics and encourage you and your child to be vaccinated and boosted. Health Screening:

Please help us continue to monitor the spread of COVID-19 by keeping students home when they are sick and not returning to school until symptoms have greatly resolved. High Point continues to provide information about illness and managing exposure through our health clinic. Email Emily Chouinard at echouinard@highpointacademy.net with questions or concerns.

COVID-19 Notification Letters and Tracking:

High Point Academy will continue to send letters to families when students are in a classroom with a positive COVID-19 case. We will continue to follow quarantine and exposure guidelines, as well as keep track of cases that are reported to us and have an impact on the school.

From county data and our tracking, we know that COVID-19 is present in our community. We also know that the COVID-19 data tracker on our website is not an accurate reflection of the true number of cases in our community. Here's why:

- We work diligently to track every case, but many cases are not reported to us.
- The lack of access to rapid home tests and the delay in PCR test notifications makes it hard to confirm a positive case.

- Some choose to stay home with symptoms instead of testing.
- With the shortened isolation guidelines, many students have returned from isolation by the time we are notified.
- For a more complete picture of how many COVID-19 cases we have in our community, please visit the <u>Tri-County Health Department</u> website.

COVID Testing:

High Point Academy will continue to provide at-home rapid COVID tests. If you need a test, please reach out to us at <u>info@highpointacademy.net</u>. Getting tested when symptoms are present is an important mitigating strategy.

Facility:

We will continue to contract with a day porter to clean high-touch surface areas and classrooms throughout the day. We will also continue with increased ventilation and air circulation in each space throughout the building. Students will continue to learn in grade level cohorts.

*At this time this change does not affect our current parent volunteer policy and current spectator policy for sporting events.

<u>Masks:</u>

High Point will continue to have KN95 and surgical-grade masks available for students or staff who want them.

These last 2+ years navigating the pandemic has been stressful and worrisome for all of us. I am grateful for your support as we took the necessary steps to keep our community as safe as possible and with your continued support and the dedication of our staff, we will continue to do so.
