COVID—19 Rapid Test Kits—UPDATE!!

The Food and Drug Administration announced that it has approved the extension request from iHealth Labs to extend the shelf life of their rapid antigen tests from **six months to nine months**.

This impacts all iHealth tests distributed by the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment since January 2022.

iHealth tests have been extended by <u>three additional months from the listed expiration date</u> and should remain stored at temperatures between 36 degrees and 86 degrees Fahrenheit. Please see the attached letter.


